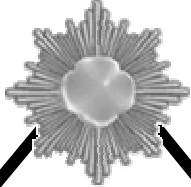


Go For It: the Girl Scout Silver Award



All steps (including submitting your Final Report) must be completed by age 14 or before the start of 10th grade.

Submit application to GSSSC Silver Advisory Team, Your project must be approved before you begin Step 5.

Must be 12 or going into 7th grade to start Steps 5 and 6.

STEP 6
Think About It

- Evaluate with your advisor
- Submit Final Report to GSSSC

STEP 5
Girl Scout Silver Award Project
(Minimum 40 hours)

- Plan It
- Know more about it
- Choose it
- Map It
- Do It

Your project can be done in or outside of Girl Scouting. If your project is done within Girl Scouting, you must reach out to the community in some way.

STEP 4
Girl Scout Silver 4 B's Challenge

- Become - set goals for self-improvement
- Belong - Do STUDIO 2B Focus Book: "Looking in, Reaching Out" *Note: The time you spend planning for your Silver Project during this step, may be applied to your Silver Project hours.*
- Believe - Focus on a community issue
- Build - Focus on a solution

STEP 2
Girl Scout Silver Leadership Award

- Earn 3 IPA related to parts of the GS Promise and Law
- Do STUDIO 2B Focus Book: "Uniquely Me: The Real Deal"
- Take action: spend 15 hours in a leadership role

STEP 3
Girl Scout Silver Career Award

- What's out there?
- Who's out there?
- Earn "Your Own Business IPA"

Use "Go For It" GS Silver Award STUDIO 2B insert to keep record and journal Steps 2-5. Good record keeping will help you evaluate in Step 6.

STEP 1
GET READY

- Read "Go For It" Girl Scout Silver Award STUDIO 2B insert, Council Silver Award Booklet OR attend a Silver Workshop
- Meet with advisor (your leader) and develop a timeline for Steps 2-4
- Make an agreement with adult advisor

Accomplishments prior to bridging or registering as a Girl Age 11-17 can not be used toward the Girl Scout Silver Award.
